This is one of the things that keeps good teachers at KVTC, even though it is still an unlicensed rural school, and why so many KVTC students do well on the national examinations, actually outperforming students from larger, better located and equipped schools!



SPENCE HOUSE STAFF RESIDENTIAL PROJECT APPROVED AND PENDING!

The need for school-owned and maintained staff housing has long been a need.

At the request of the Kibbuse Foundation Board, FOK has held in interest bearing savings more than \$32,000 toward the \$57,000 needed to complete exterior and interior finishing of the two-story "Spence House" on the hill overlooking the school campus. The original construction was funded by a very generous bequest from the lan and Rachel Spence family. Ian and Rachel, from the UK, served at Kibbuse in 2,002-03, shortly after the school was founded. We hope and pray that their good faith investment will finally become "sight" within this calendar year.
